 - * Gerry Horgan died in 1989 after being struck by a speeding vehicle while walking the picket line. The vehicle was being driven by the teenage daughter of a manager she was never charged for his death. We wear red to remember the tragedy and symbolize the sacrifice Gerry made that day to fight for workers rights. Wearing red to show solidarity took on a new meaning during Wisconsin Governor Scott Walker's relentless acts on labor in 2011. Unionists around the country showed solidarity by wearing red shirts once a week.
 - * Today it remains an act of showing unity, both to one another and the world. It's not anti-management; it's a positive statement of workers standing together.
